

Jefferson Yarn Extravaganza

Working with the Arts Alliance of Greater Jefferson, Tomorrow's Hope invites individuals, families, businesses and organizations to **Adopt-a-Post to Yarn Bomb in Rotary Park!** Crafters and professionals are invited to create a colorful knitted or crocheted installation to wrap around their column. The result will be public art which adds a bit of whimsy to the summer scene in Rotary Park. Sponsors can name the wrap "in honor or memory" of individual(s) of your choice.

Dates: Yarn Bombing: July 18th at 5:00 p.m.
Removed: October 22nd

Rules:

1. Sponsorship per post: \$50
2. Tomorrow's Hope and the Arts Alliance will assign you one of 21 posts in Rotary Park.
3. Each column is 7 ½" X 7 ½" around. Wraps should be 50" tall and hung just below the "Y" support beam.
4. Artists sign a contract stating:
 - a. Crafters and artisans can cause no harm to the column.
 - b. Columns cannot be punctured (i.e., staples or nails)
 - c. Use acrylic yarn NOT wool yarn.
 - d. You must wash your wrap in cold water (to prevent color dying onto the column) prior to attaching it to the column.
 - e. The wrap must be attached to the "Y" support beam at the top of the column to ensure the wrap does not fall.
5. The organizations and the City reserve the right to remove any decoration they feel:
 - a. Could harm the column.
 - b. Is offensive in any way as determined by Tomorrow's Hope or the City.
 - c. Looks messy or is inappropriate.
6. Everyone must keep the "bombing" date a secret!
7. Tomorrow's Hope will provide signage that must be attached to your design showing sponsor, who it is in honor or memory of, and the crafters.
8. Tomorrow's Hope and the Arts Alliance are not responsible for any damage to the post or any harm that may come to any individual while working on this project.
